



NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

**Locations: Broom Street,
Douglas Drive and Robson Street**

Project Details:

The Township of North Dumfries contractor, Coco Paving Inc., will be doing road resurfacing repairs on your street starting June 2nd for approximately 2 weeks (weather depending). These repairs include, milling, removing and replacing broken curbs, re-setting manhole covers and catch basins, and, paving of the top lift of asphalt.



Stages (dates are approximate)

June 2 – milling

June 3 & June 4 – removing and replacing broken curbs, re-setting manhole covers and catch basins

June 5 or June 8 – paving of top lift of asphalt

Additional project information you need to know:

Driveway Access

Driveway access may be interrupted for minimal periods of time. During the resurfacing project, we will make a concerted effort to maintain access to your driveway, however, Staff and Representatives from Coco Paving Inc. will make best efforts to advise residents in advance if your driveway will be blocked temporarily. If you are unable to enter driveway due to construction, please park your vehicle on an adjacent side street or elsewhere in order to accommodate construction activities.

Parking

To ensure an effective and efficient project, residents are asked to **not** park vehicles on the road between, 6:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., during construction. However, if residents must park on the road, the Township permits vehicles to park and leave a vehicle in the parking lot at Piper's Glen Park and adjacent streets. All parking signs and regulations must be obeyed. The *Traffic and Parking Bylaw #2559-13 Part V s.2(a)(ix) Parked on a highway for a longer period of time than*

three (3) consecutive hours will be waived for residents unable to access their driveway. Vehicles impeding the construction will be tagged by the Township's By-Law Enforcement.

Encroachment

Construction may affect private lawn features within the city boulevard. Homeowners are responsible for removing items such as **gardens, lawn sprinklers, hedges, driveway timber/concrete edges, etc.** to avoid unintentional damage due to the construction. **Sprinkler systems and lawn features mention above that are damaged by the construction work will not be repaired.**

Network Outages

Due to the nature of the work, it is common for network outages to occur on telephone, cable and/or internet services. Please note that any outages that are discovered Monday to Friday between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. can be reported to the Township of North Dumfries. Outages discovered outside of these times should be reported to your service provider.

Sod

Grass boulevards damaged by construction will be repaired. Please note, only the boulevard area impacted by the construction will be repaired as the Township does not provide full boulevard replacement. We appreciate your efforts to water and maintain the new sod.

Note

Waste collection and mail services will not be disrupted. Residents are advised that entering into a contract with contractors working on the Township's project for additional work on private property shall be done at the homeowner's discretion. The Township **cannot be involved** with any private contracts.
