

Election Worker Application

Thank you for your interest in applying for an election worker position with the Township of North Dumfries for the 2026 Municipal Elections.

The Township is recruiting election workers for a variety of positions on:

- Training days late September or early October
- Advanced Poll: Wednesday, October 21, 2026
- Advanced Poll: Saturday, October 24, 2026
- Election Day: Monday, October 26, 2026

Election workers must:

- be a Canadian citizen
- be 18 years of age or older
- attend required training events
- arrive at the polling location an hour before it opens
- remain at the polling location for the entire shift
- be able to perform repetitive tasks that require attention to detail

Positions Available:

- **Poll Clerk / Revision Clerk:** add individuals to the voters' list, strike voters off voters' list, issue paper ballots, check identification and verify electors
- **Tabulator Clerk:** individual assigned to monitor tabulator at voting locations, feed ballots through tabulator, ensure ballots are cast correctly, clean (sanitize) surfaces, ensure supplies are available
- **Greeter:** greet public at entrance, direct public, ensure electors with accessibility needs are accommodated, review voter cards, provide general information

Pay: \$20.00/hour - \$23.60/hour

Locations: one of four polling locations across the Township of North Dumfries
