To whom it may concern,

TMHC Inc. has been retained by the Greenfield Mill Co. to complete a Stage 1-2 archaeological assessment of 3089 Greenfield Road in the Township of North Dumfries, Regional Municipality of Waterloo, ON.

The archaeological assessment is being completed as part of Greenfield Mill Co.'s redevelopment project which will see the 19th-century mill on the property renovated and repurposed as a modern events centre. The archaeological assessment is required to meet conditions of applications being made under the *Planning Act*. The entirety of the parcel will be subject to archaeological assessment.

Archaeology is mandated and protected by the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. 0.18. All archaeological assessments must be conducted in accordance with the technical standards, as defined in the *Standards and Guidelines for Consultant Archaeologists*, 2011, set out by the Ministry of Citizenship and Multiculturalism. All archaeological assessments must be completed by a consultant archaeologist with a license from the Ontario government.

The assessment will involve engagement with the Six Nations of the Grand River, the Haudenosaunee Confederacy Chiefs Council as represented by the Haudenosaunee Development Institute and Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation.

All archaeological assessment activities will be performed under the professional archaeological license of Liam Browne, MA (P1048). The archaeological assessment is planned for the spring of 2026.
